



Much of her work focuses on cityscapes, suburbs, everyday people, urban architecture, crowds, sea and coastlines (especially Cape Town). She tends to use black ink in layered washes,

linework, and sometimes mixed media. The layering gives depth, contrast, somewhat photographic quality in some of her works.
